TRAVEL GUIDANCE

Beginning August 25, 2021 any staff or student that is returning from international travel before returning to school in-person must be symptom-free and provide a negative Covid test (PCR or rapid test) taken after he or she returned to the United States and prior to attending school.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS BRYANT NOTIFICATION CENTER

Please remind your child to check the Student Item Pickup Board located in the hallway between the main front doors and the office for items that have been dropped off in the drop box. A large note with the student name will be posted on the board. They should remove the note and bring it to the office to retrieve the item. This includes, but is not limited to: lunch, homework, instruments, keys, money, backpacks, donuts, gym clothes, sock, shoes, swim wear, books, etc. This is to reduce interruptions in the classroom.

The office staff will not interrupt class for forgotten/dropped off items.

Dearborn High host Oct. 29 **vaccination Clinic**

Worried about COVID making you miss more school activities, sports practices, time with friends, and even – should we say it – class? Dearborn High School is hosting a free COVID vaccination clinic on Friday, Oct. 29 from 1 to 4 p.m. The Wayne County Health Department will be on hand administering Pfizer vaccines to students, staff, and community members in the school cafeteria. Please enter from the south side of the building, facing the football field.

The clinic is for anyone 12 years or older who is not yet vaccinated or those who received their second Pfizer vaccine more than six months ago and are now among [the groups eligible for a booster shot](#). School district staff are included in those eligible for a booster shot.

[Pre-registration](#) is requested, but not required, for the clinic. Pre-registering will help ensure enough vaccines are available for all who plan to attend. Dearborn High students who pre-register can be excused from the fifth and sixth hours that day to get vaccinated.

The Pfizer vaccine can be given to anyone age 12 or older. Anyone younger than 18 must have a signed [permission form](#) from a parent or guardian. Parents can sign the form on-site, if they are attending with their child, or can print and sign the form and send it with their child to the clinic.

“Since COVID vaccines became available first to district staff and then to students, we have strongly encouraged everyone who is eligible to get vaccinated against this virus,” said Dearborn Schools Superintendent Glenn Maleyko. “This clinic is another way to try to keep our school community as safe as we can during a pandemic and to lessen as much as possible the damage COVID is causing to the people in our community and to the learning opportunities for our students.

Athletic Physical Forms for 2021/22 School Year



For your planning purposes, the MHSAA has announced that all athletes playing a school sport in the 2021-22 school year will need to have a new athletic physical on file before participating.

We **will not** be using the health questionnaire next school year. The MHSAA physical form can be found here: <https://www.mhsaa.com/portals/0/documents/health%20safety/physical2page.pdf>.

Also, any physical dated after 4/15/2021 is valid for the 2021-22 school year so it's ok to start completing this requirement now.



COVID-19 screening tool

Staff and visitors, if you answer "yes" to any of these questions, you must stay home from school today. Parents and guardians, if your child would answer yes to any of these questions, they must be kept home from school.

Question 1: Do you have any **new, unusual** or **worsening** symptoms listed in Boxes A and B below?

If you answered "yes" in either box above, then stay home and consult your primary care doctor. If a doctor determines the symptoms are due to another diagnosis, or if COVID-19 is ruled out, you may return to school after at least 24 hours fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medicine and without vomiting.

Question 2: In the last 10 days have you been identified as a close contact of anyone who has had a positive COVID-19 diagnostic test? You may answer "No" if:

- It has been more than two weeks since you received the second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or one dose of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine
- Within the past five months you had a positive PCR test for COVID, unless the test was within the last 10 days.

If you answer "yes", then stay home to quarantine for at least 10 days from the last exposure to the close contact. In some situations, you may be able to return sooner with regular COVID testing. See our current quarantine guidelines. If symptoms appear, you must stay home for at least 10 days after your symptoms started and until any cough, fever or other symptoms have improved. (See symptoms section above.)

Question 3: Have you returned from international travel in the last 10 days? You may answer "No" if you had a negative COVID test (PCR or rapid) after returning to the United States.

If you answer "yes", then stay home until you have a COVID test and the results are negative.
