

## RESCISSION OF EMERGENCY ORDER FOR CONTROL OF PANDEMIC

Today, I, Dr. Avani Sheth, am rescinding the Emergency Order for Control of Pandemic issued on August 27, 2021, entitled "COVID-19 Prevention through the Wearing of Face Masks in Educational Settings within the Jurisdiction of the Wayne County Michigan Local Health Department."

Although I am rescinding this Order, masking remains important for the following reasons:

- Masking continues to be recommended as an important tool to decrease the spread of COVID-19.
- Children should continue to be supported to wear a mask, including but not limited to for reasons such as individual and/or household risk factors and vaccination status.
- Masking continues to be recommended as part of isolation and quarantine periods.

As a reminder, children and adults in schools who are sick or have COVID-19 symptoms should stay home and get tested.

Rescission of the August 27, 2021 Emergency Order for Control of Pandemic entitled "COVID-19 Prevention through the Wearing of Face Masks in Educational Settings within the Jurisdiction of the Wayne County Michigan Local Health Department" is effective on Thursday, February 17, 2022 at 8:00 a.m.
