

Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP) & PSAT 8 Tests

Dear Parents,

This spring students will be taking the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP) and PSAT 8 Tests (8th grade only). The testing window for administering these tests begins Monday, April 11°. All 8th graders will be tested during the first three weeks of the testing window (the last day for testing for 8th graders will be Friday, April 29th). The 6th and 7th graders will begin testing during the week of May 9th and complete testing before Friday, May 21st.

This year, 8th graders will take the PSAT 8 Tests (Evidence Based Reading and Writing and Math) in addition to M-Step Social Studies tests and M-Step Science tests. The PSAT 8 Tests will be given on Wednesday, April 13th. These tests are timed and will take students 2 hours and 35 minutes to complete. If your child needs additional time to take these tests as documented in an IEP or 504 plan, he/she will take that test at a later date during that week; some EL students will be given extended time to test. Students who miss the April 13th testing date will be required to take the tests during the PSAT 8/9 make-up testing window on Tuesday, April 26th or Wednesday, April 27th. The M-Step Social Studies and M-Step Science tests will be given on Tuesday, April 19th and Thursday, April 21st, respectively.

Students in grades 6 and 7 will take the English Language Arts and the Mathematics assessments, which will include both openended responses and multiple choice questions. These tests are very difficult and measure how students apply knowledge. These tests will be administered during the morning over a two week period, starting Tuesday, May 10th.

- *Get up early enough to avoid hurrying to get ready for school.

During the Test:

- *Relax and stay calm.
- *Listen carefully to the directions the teacher gives.
- *Ask questions if you don't understand what to do.

^{*}Eat a healthy breakfast.

*Read each question carefully. Find the key words. Try to figure out what the question is really asking.

*Read the entire question and look at all the answer choices.

*Use strategies you learned in class to figure out the answer.

*Take your time picking the best answer; if the test is timed, answer all questions within the allotted time.

الآباء الأعزاء،

سيخضع الطلاب في ربيع هذا العام لاختبارات ولاية ميشيغان الرسمية لقياس التقدم التعليمي الـ (M-STEP) واختبار الـ PSAT (طلاب الصف الثامن فقط). تبدأ هذه الاختبارات يوم الاثنين ١١ نيسان / أبريل، سيتم اختبار جميع طلاب الصف الثامن خلال الأسابيع الثلاثة الأولى من الوقت المحدد للاختبار (سيأخر أيام اختبارات طلاب الصف الثامن هو الجمعة، 29 نيسان/أبريل). سيبدأ طلاب الصف السادس والسابع الاختبار خلال أسبوع ٩ أيار/مايو ويستكملون الاختبار قبل يوم الجمعة ٢١ أيار/مايو.

كما سيجري طلاب الصف الثامن هذا العام، اختبارات PSAT 8 (القراءة القائمة على الأدلة والكتابة والرياضيات) بالإضافة إلى اختبارات الام ستيبب في المواد التالية: الدراسات الاجتماعية والعلوم. سيتم إجراء اختبارات PSAT 8 الصف الثامن يوم الأربعاء الموافق ١٣ نيسان/ أبريل. هذه الاختبارات محددة الوقت سيستغرق الطلاب ساعتين و٣٥ دقيقة لإكمالها. إذا احتاج طفلك إلى وقت إضافي لإجراء هذه الاختبارات كما هو موثق في برنامج التعليم الفردي أو خطة 504، فسوف يخضع لهذا الاختبار في تاريخ لاحق خلال ذلك الأسبوع؛ سيتم منح بعض طلاب دارسي الإنجليزية وقتًا طويلاً للاختبار. سيطلب من الطلاب الذين يفوتون موحد اختبار ١٣ أبريل إجراء الاختبار التختبارات خلال الأوقات التعويضية PSAT 8/9 يوم الثلاثاء أو ٢٦ نيسان/أبريل أو الأربعاء ٢٧ نيسان/أبريل. سيتم إجراء اختبارات الام ستيب في المواد التالية الدراسات الاجتماعية والعلوم يومي الثلاثاء 19 نيسان/أبريل والخميس ٢١ نيسان/أبريل على التوالي.

سبجري الطلاب في الصفين السادس والسابع تقييمات اللغة الإنجليزية والرياضيات، والتي ستتضمن كلاً من الإجابات المفتوحة وأسئلة الاختيار من متعدد. هذه الاختيارات صعبة للغاية وتقيس كيفية تطبيق الطلاب للمعرفة. سيتم إجراء هذه الاختيارات في الصباح على مدار أسبو عين، اعتبارًا من الثلاثاء ١٠ أيار/مايو.

TRAVEL GUIDANCE

Beginning August 25, 2021 any staff or student that is returning from international travel before returning to school in-person must be symptom-free and provide a negative Covid test (PCR or rapid test) taken after he or she returned to the United States and prior to attending school.

District drops face mask requirement in schools...

Face masks will become optional for all students and staff inside Dearborn Public Schools starting on Wednesday, Feb. 23 as students return from mid-winter break.

Under federal law, masks will still be required on all school buses. Well-fitting masks are also still required for anyone returning from quarantine less than 10 days after their exposure. (See our quarantine guidelines.) Those unable or unwilling to wear a mask need to complete the full 10 day quarantine at home.

Any student or staff who prefers to wear a face mask inside a school building or elsewhere on school grounds may continue to do so.

Dearborn Schools COVID Quarantine and Isolation Requirements



Quarantine

Quarantine applies to someone who may have been exposed to a virus and needs to stay away from others to reduce the risk of spread. This box shows what to do if you were exposed outside of school and have no symptoms. If you develop symptoms, you should isolate until you can be tested. For quarantine, day 0 is the day of exposure.

Fully vaccinated

Defined by the county as two weeks after the final dose for your vaccine type or
Had a confirmed case of COVID in the last

90 days

No need to quarantine

Those without symptoms do not need to quarantine. They should monitor for symptoms and wear a <u>well-fitting</u> mask for 10 days.

Xth

Not fully vaccinated

Quarantine through day 5 after exposure

On day 6, you may return to school if: you meet all of the following:

- You have not developed any symptoms and have not tested positive for COVID AND
- Test negative for COVID on day 5 (home tests are not accepted) AND
- Continue to wear a <u>well-fitting</u> mask for the next five days.

Isolation

Isolation applies to any one who has tested positive for COVID or who has symptoms and has not yet received a negative PCR or rapid test result or other diagnosis. (Negative home COVID tests are not accepted.) For isolation, day 0 is the first day of symptoms or the date of the positive test.



If you test positive for COVID or have symptoms and have not tested You may return as early as Day 6, if you meet ALL of the following conditions.

- Fever free for 24 hours without using fever reducing medications AND
- Significant improvement in symptoms or are without symptoms AND
- Continue to wear a <u>well-fitting</u> mask through day 10.

Students and staff should continue to stay home past day 6 if they do not feel well. Student absences are automatically excused through 10 days after the start of the illness.

All students must provide <u>proof of age</u> by any of the following:

Students must also bring their social security card and proof of diploma if they are a high school graduate or their college transcript.

Registration for ESL will take approximately 2-3 hours.

This will include an assessment test for proper placement.
