


Bryant Summer Academic and Enrichment Program (2022) For the second year in a row, Dearborn Public Schools is offering all of its students free summer academic and enrichment learning programs.

Bryant Middle School students can participate in the Summer Academic and Enrichment Program. The program will run in-person, at-school Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The program starts on Monday, June 27th and ends on Thursday, July 28th. The program is free for all participants, but there is a limited time to enroll your child (ren) in the program. **The enrollment window is open from now until Friday, May 15th.** This summer, incoming 5th graders will join the program in the middle schools while the 8th graders will attend the program at the high schools.

For many years, Dearborn Public Schools has run summer school programs at all grade levels, but typically those programs focus on students who are struggling academically. The summer 2022 Academic and Enrichment program is open to all students. We are excited about the potential of having a number of Bryant students attend the summer program again this summer.

District drops face mask requirement in schools...

Face masks will become optional for all students and staff inside Dearborn Public Schools starting on Wednesday, Feb. 23 as students return from mid-winter break.

Under federal law, masks will still be required on all school buses. Well-fitting masks are also still required for anyone returning from quarantine less than 10 days after their exposure. (See our quarantine guidelines.) Those unable or unwilling to wear a mask need to complete the full 10 day quarantine at home.

Any student or staff who prefers to wear a face mask inside a school building or elsewhere on school grounds may continue to do so.



Dearborn Schools COVID Quarantine and Isolation Requirements




Quarantine

Quarantine applies to someone who may have been exposed to a virus and needs to stay away from others to reduce the risk of spread. This box shows what to do if you were exposed outside of school and have no symptoms. If you develop symptoms, you should isolate until you can be tested. For quarantine, day 0 is the day of exposure.



Isolation

Isolation applies to any one who has tested positive for COVID or who has symptoms and has not yet received a negative PCR or rapid test result or other diagnosis. (Negative home COVID tests are not accepted.) For isolation, day 0 is the first day of symptoms or the date of the positive test.

ELIGIBILITY: Students must be 18 years or older as of September 1st and must NOT be enrolled in high school.

There will be a \$20 non-refundable registration fee at the time of registration for all.

All students must provide proof of age by any of the following: • Driver's license, state ID, Birth certificate or passport

Students must also bring their social security card and proof of diploma if they are a high school graduate or their college transcript.

Registration for ESL will take approximately 2-3 hours. This will include an assessment test for proper placement.

Do not bring children with you or another appointment will have to be scheduled.
