When going to vote you can request one of three ballots; Democrat, Republican, or non-partisan.

You can make your voice heard in the federal Presidential Primary and vote on the two local ballot questions.





Dearborn Public Schools Operating Millage Renewal The Operating Millage makes up 16 percent, or \$41 million, of the district's general fund.

Loss of this income (a total of \$2,030 per student) would give Dearborn Schools one of the lowest per-pupil funding revenues in Michigan and result in spending cuts across almost all schools and programs.

With this renewal, homeowners would see their maximum tax capped at 4 mills, down from the current 6.17 mills. Businesses would continue to pay 18 mills.

The Operating Millage Renewal is not a bond for building projects. Revenue from the Operating Millage is used for the day-to-day expenses to run the district.

The operating millage directly affects students.

Almost 80 percent of the general fund is used for staffing, including teachers, parapros, secretaries, and more.

تجديد النسبة الضريبية التشغيلية = مدارس ديربورن الرسمية تُشكل هذه النسبة 16% أو 41 مليون دولار من أموال صندوق التمويل العام للقطاع التعليمي

إن خسارة هذا الدخل (إجمالي 2030 دولارًا لكل طالب) من شأته أن يجعل مدارس ديريورن واحدة من المدأرس الحاصلة على أدنى مبلغ تمويل عن كل تلميذ في ولاية ميشيغان ويؤدي إلى خفض الإنفاق في جميع المدارس والبرامج تقريبًا.

سيرى أصحاب المنازل مع هذا التجديد انخفاض الحد الأقصى لنسبة الضريبة إلى 4 مُل، بانخفاض 6.17 عن النسبة الحالية. سوف تستمر الشركات في دفع 18 مُل.

إن تجديد النسبة الضريبية التشغيلية ليس سنداً لمشاريع البناء. يتم استخدام الإيرادات من الضرائب التشغيلية لتغطية النفقات اليومية لإدارة القطاع التعليمي.

تؤثر النسبة الضريبية التشغيلية (مُل) بشكل مباشر على الطلاب. يتم استخدام ما يقرب من 80 بالمائة من أموال صندوق التمويل العام للتوظيف، بما في ذلك المعلمين والمعلمين المساعدين والسكرتيرات وغيرهم.

- The Operational Millage brings \$41 million into our General Fund budget; that is 16% of the budget.
- Without this funding, the district would sink to one of the lowest per-pupil general fund revenues in Michigan.
- This is a millage renewal, **not** a **new tax.** For homeowners, the Operational Millage would drop from a maximum of 6.17 mills to 4 mills. The district assessed 2.04 mills for this year and expects the rate to settle at about 2.5 mills. The ballot will read 4 mills in case conditions change. The rate for homeowners could not go above 4 mills.
- For businesses in the district, the millage rate will stay at the 18 mill rate created with Proposal A changed school funding in 1994. This is where the majority of the funding (\$34 million of the \$41 million) comes from. This rate also applies if you own rental property.
- The *Operational Millage* is part of the General Fund, which is used for daily operations. This money pays for staff, utility bills, classroom supplies, busing, etc. This is NOT A BOND proposal. This would not fund any major school construction or renovation projects.
- If the *Operational Millage Renewal* does not pass, the district would need to cut \$41 million from the budget. A 16% cut in daily expenses and would likely result in reductions in almost all programs and staffing areas.

شاركوا في انتخابات ۲۷ شباط (فبراير) ۲۰۲٤

- يجلب برنامج المُلج التشغيلي مبلغ ٤١ مليون دو لار إلى صندوق الميزانية العامة؛ أي ١٦ % من إجمالي الميز انية.
- بدون هذا التمويل، سينخفض تمويل القطاع التعليمي إلى واحدًا من أدنى إير ادات الميز انية العامة لكل طالب في مشيغان.
- هذا اقتراع لتجديد المُل (نسبة الضريبة الحالية) وليس لفرض ضريبة جديدة. بالنسبة لأصحاب المنازل، ستنخفض قيمة المُلج التشغيلي من ١٠٠٦ مُل كحد أقصى إلى ٤ مُل. قام القطاع بتقييم ٢٠٠٤ مُل لهذا العام وتتوقع أن يستقر المعدل عند حوالي ٢٠٥ مُل. ستقرأ بطاقة الاقتراع ٤ مُل في حالة تغير الظروف. لا يمكن أن بتجاوز المعدل لأصحاب المنازل ٤ مُل.
- بالنسبة للأعمال في القطاع، سيبقى معدل المُل في حدود ١٨ مُل المطلوبة من الولاية. ومن هنا تأتي غالبية التمويل (٣٤ مليون دولار من أصل ٤١ مليون دولار). تنطبق هذه النسبة المالية أيضًا على ملكيتك المؤجرة.

- المُلج التشغيلي هو جزء من الصندوق التمويل العام الذي يستخدم للعمليات اليومية. تُدفع هذه الأموال للموظفين، وفواتير الخدمات، ولوازم الفصول الدراسية، والحافلات، وما إلى ذلك. الرجاء الانتباه إلى أن هذا ليس اقتراح سندات ولن يستخدم لتمويل أي مشاريع بناء أو تجديد كبرى للمدارس.
- إذا لم يتم تمرير مشروع تجديد المُلج التشغيلي، فسوف يتعين على القطاع خفض ٤١ مليون دولار من الميزانية بنسبة ١٦ % في النفقات اليومية ومن المرجح أن يؤدي ذلك إلى التخفيض في خدمات جميع البرامج ومجالات التوظيف تقريبًا.

FBI Warns of Online Groups Targeting Minors

The FBI is alerting the public to the deliberate targeting of minor victims by violent online groups on widely accessible messaging platforms. These groups aim to coerce victims between the ages of 8 and 17 years old to produce content involving selfharm, explicit sexual acts, and/or suicide. Being specifically targeted are LGBTQ+ youth, racial minorities, and those struggling with mental health issues. Utilizing threats, blackmail, and manipulation, the groups exert control over victims by pressuring them. There are many active group names including 676, 764, CVLT, Court, Kaskar, Harm Nation, Leak Society, and H3II, with subgroups continuously formed under different nicknames. When to Keep Your Child Home From School

Coronavirus Infection Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Children with a positive COVID-19 test or displaying symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home until they have had no fever for 24 hours without use of fever-reducing medication AND improvement of symptoms AND have isolated for the appropriate amount of time as recommended by our local health department.

Chickenpox

Keep child home until they have no new sores for 24 hours AND all sores are dried and crusted. During an outbreak of chickenpox, children who are NOT vaccinated for chickenpox (Varicella) and have been in close contact with someone sick with the infection will not be allowed at school for 21 days after they were last exposed to chickenpox, even if they are not sick.

Diarrhea

Keep child home until seen by a doctor and treated if needed. The school may request a doctor's note to return to school

Fever

Keep child home with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher. Keep child home until fever-free for 24 hours without using fever-reducing medicines such as Motrin and Tylenol. Contact your child's primary care physician and provide a doctor's note for their return to school.

Flu-like symptoms

Sudden onset of fever, chills, muscle aches; may also have vomiting and diarrhea. Keep child home until symptom-free for 24 hours. Contact your child's primary care physician and provide a doctor's note for their return to school.

Head Lice

Keep child home until treatment is completed and no eggs closer than 1/4 inch to the scalp and all live lice are gone.

Vomiting

Keep child home until no vomiting for 24 hours.

Impetigo

Keep child home until treatment has been started. Lesions must be covered while in school.

MRSA

Keep child home if sore is draining, and cannot be covered with a clean, dry bandage. Keep child home if they cannot keep from picking at sore.

Rash

Keep child home until seen by a doctor and treated if needed. The school may request a doctor's note to return to school.

Strep throat

Keep child home until 24 hours after the first dose of antibiotics has been started.

Pink eye

Keep child home until 24 hours after the first dose of antibiotics has been started.

Ringworm

Keep child home until seen by a doctor and until treatment has been started. Area must remain covered at school until completely healed.

Scabies

Keep child home until treatment is completed.

Abdominal Pain

Keep child home with abdominal pain that continues for more than 2 hours.
